Language & Culture Barriers



- It leads more misunderstandings between employers and migrant workers.
- Limited opportunities to participate in social activities exacerbate their mental stress.
- Due to language difficulties, migrant workers are unable to effectively adovocate for their rights.

SOLUTIONS

- Translators and online translation tools
- The Long-Term Care 2.0 program
- Service associations and foundations

EXAMPLES

- Although they have received Mandarin training, elderly people in Taiwan are more accustomed to speaking Taiwanese.
- Taiwanese cuisine often uses pork, but Muslim caregivers cannot eat pork.
- Both parties to communicate through gestures, leading to even more misunderstandings.
 - Poor communication may prevent caregivers from fully utilizing their professional skills.
