

FJCU'S CO2 REDUCTION PROGRAM:

Example 1

After replacing the lamps in six buildings with LEDs, annual CO2 emissions were reduced by 939.4 tons.



Example 2

In 2019, 133 air conditioners in the school were replaced with first-Class energy-saving air conditioners, which are 10% to 15% more energy efficient than those without energy-saving air conditioners.
