-They pay attention to every detail so that each product can be matched according to personal preferences. (1) reflects their emphasis on environmental protection (2) reduce the carbon footprint of the apparel industry and achieving an environment where fashion and sustainability can coexist.





Sustainable Fashion

The definition of sustainable fashion contains several important elements.

- Environmental sustainability is at its core, which includes everything from raw material selection, production process to transportation.
- Brands must focus on reducing carbon emissions and effectively utilizing resources, especially in the use of environmentally friendly materials, such as recycled fibers and recycled fabrics.







- Transparent product labeling cannot be ignored, so that consumers can clearly understand the ingredients of the clothes they buy and avoid being misled by marketing.
- Sustainable fashion also emphasizes labor rights
 - (1) ensuring that there is no unfair working conditions during the production process.
 - (2)advocates animal-friendliness, choosing artificial materials to replace animal fur, further achieving the effect of balancing environmental protection.

- The shells are ground into powder and blended with recycled PET to create a durable yarn.
- This fabric is antibacterial, UV-protective, and odor-resistant, perfect for activewear and everyday clothing.
- It also helps reduce marine waste and promotes coastal recycling initiatives.
