- **Facts & Figures:**

1. If the global population reaches 9.8 billion by 2050, the equivalent of almost three planets will be required to sustain current lifestyles.
2. Over 1.3 billion tons of food is wasted every year.
3. Only 9% of plastic waste has ever been recycled.

- **Impact:**

1. Unsustainable consumption and production drive environmental degradation, climate change, and biodiversity loss.
